





Continuance of Assistance

If you need continuance of assistance after your initial application, submit the Continuance of Assistance Request Form and tell us why you require continued assistance.

Documents you will need to submit with your request are an updated copies of your last 2 pay stubs, rental ledger and latest utility billing(s). Continuance status is for 3 months at a time, and staff will reassess your application at the end of each 3-month period as long as you have not reached the maximum capacity of 18 months per household, at all previous assisted locations allowed by the U.S. Treasury.

Continuance of Assistance form must be submitted to the ERA Program office located on the 2nd floor, Suite 219, ITC building in Tamuning, 8:00am to 4:00pm Monday to Friday.
